

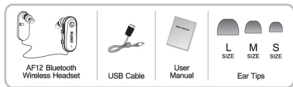

1. INTRODUCTION

Bluetooth is a short-distance two-way wireless communication technology capable of transmitting data, commands, and audio between devices. The AF12 can connect to many devices, including mobile phones, tablets, PDAs, computers, media players, and more through a process called pairing, which will need to be done before you can use your AF12. Once paired, if your phone supports the A2DP Bluetooth profile and has a music player feature, you can use the phone to make and receive calls, listen to stereo audio, and control media playback with the headset.

3. WARNING

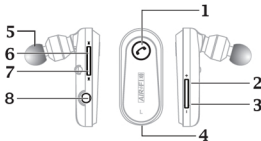
Turn down the volume prior to using the headphones; adjust the volume to the desired level once they are connected. Do not use headphones at high volumes for extended periods of time. Doing so will result in permanent hearing damage. It is advised you keep volume levels moderate to low at all times for your safety, even when loud background noise is present. Please visit www.osha.gov for more information. Do not use in both ears while driving a car, cycling, operating machinery, or performing other activities that require hearing surrounding sounds.

4. SAFETY GUIDE

When using your headset while driving, please follow the local regulations of your country or region and do not place both headphones in your ears.

- Do not use your headset around flammable gases as fire or explosion may occur.
- There are no user replaceable/repairable parts in the headset. Disassembling it will void your warranty.
- Do not expose the headset to moisture, water, or other liquids. Doing so will void your warranty.
- Keep the device and packaging out of the reach of children.

5. PRODUCT FEATURES



1. Multifunction key (on/off, answer, end, pair, play and pause.)
2. Volume + key
3. Volume - key
4. Microphone
5. Ear tip

6. CHARGING EARPHONE

*** You must charge the headset for at least 4 hours before the first use ***



- a.) Connect the charging cable to a powered USB port and to the AF12. The Red indicator light is displayed during charging. Charging the battery fully may take about 4 hours for the first charge and may take up to 2 hours for subsequent charges.
- b.) When the battery is fully charged, the Red indicator light will turn off. The fully charged battery has power for up to 5 hours of talk time, up to 4.5 hours of music playback time, or up to 100 hours of standby time.

7. WEARING



Each earphone is marked with a channel indicator, "R" for right and "L" for left. The cable is designed to be worn over-the-ear and behind the neck with the tethering cable behind your head. The housing of the earphone is to face forward as shown in the image.

8. TURNING ON AND OFF

To turn the AF12 on, press and hold the multifunction key for about 3 seconds. The Blue indicator light will flash twice when turning on and there will be a long tone. Once turned on, the AF12 may connect with any paired device that has Bluetooth enabled and is within range. If the AF12 is not connected, the blue light will flash once every 3 seconds. Once a connection is made, there will be two audible tones and the blue light will flash 3 times every 3 seconds.

To turn the AF12 off, press and hold the multifunction key until the Red indicator light starts flashing. It will flash 5 times while shutting down and produce a single long beep.

9. PAIR THE HEADSET

- Make sure your AF12 is off and has received a full charge
- Press and hold the multifunction key for about 5 seconds until the Red and Blue indicator lights start flashing alternately; there will be an audible double beep to indicate that pairing mode has been activated.
- Enable Bluetooth on your device if it is not already on.
- Search for Bluetooth devices and select AF12 from the list of founded devices. If a passcode is required, use 0000 to pair and connect the headset to your device.
- When the headset is connected to your device and is ready for use, the Blue indicator light will flash 3 quick times every 3 seconds.

Note: The AF12 will stay in pairing mode for a minute and a half and will shut down if not paired within that time.

10. CONNECTING

*** In order to connect, you must first pair your device with the AF12. The AF12 should only need to be paired once with each device. ***

- Make sure Bluetooth on your paired device is on and the device is not connected to any other Bluetooth product. If other paired Bluetooth devices are in the area with Bluetooth enabled, the AF12 may pair with that device first.
- Once turned on, the AF12 will attempt to connect. Check your device for any onscreen instructions for connection to the AF12. When a connection is made, there will be two audible tones.

11. CONTROLLING PHONE CALLS

*** The AF12 must be connected to a Phone ***

Answering a Phone Call: To receive an incoming call, press the multifunction button once. If music is playing when a call comes in, the music will stop playback until the call is either ended or rejected.

If you answer on your phone instead of the headset the following will occur:

- iPhone: The handset on the iPhone will be active for the call, not your AF12; check your phone instructions on how to transfer the call to the AF12 from your phone
- Android phone: The AF12 headset will answer the call.
- Blackberry phone: The call will be defaulted to the handset, but

a menu will ask if you want to use the Bluetooth device or the phone handset.

Ending a Phone Call: Press the multifunction button once. Alternatively you can end the call by pressing the end call button on your phone.

Rejecting a Call^{*}: When a call is incoming, press the multifunction button twice in rapid succession.

Activating Voice Dialing^{*}: Press and hold the Multifunction button for two seconds.

Redialing the Last Number^{*}: When no call is in progress, press the multi-function button twice in rapid succession.

Note: The functions marked with ^{*} must be supported by your mobile phone. For more information, refer to the User Manual of your mobile phone.

12. CONTROLLING AUDIO/VIDEO

Play/Pause: When compatible media playback software is running (depends on the device and player), press the Play/Pause button to alternate between playback and pausing audio. On some devices, with multi-thread capability, functionality will be dependent on if the software is running in the forefront or background.

Skipping Tracks: Press the **▶**(next) or **◀**(previous) button to skip tracks on compatible media player. If you are at the beginning of a track (within the first few seconds of the start) the previous button will skip to the previous track. If the audio has been playing longer, the previous button will restart the track and a double click will skip to the previous track.

Adjusting the Volume: The + button increases the volume and the - button decreases the volume. When you reach maximum or minimum volume, there will be an audible beep. Pressing and holding the button will continuously adjust the volume until it has reached the maximum or minimum.

13. MAINTAIN YOUR AF12

- When not in use, power the device off and store in the included protective case.
- Avoid extreme temperatures (45°C/113°F and above, including direct sunlight, or -10°C/14°F below) for storage as they will shorten the service life of the battery.
- If the device comes in contact with liquids, quickly wipe away. If submerged in water, do not turn the device on until completely dried. Note: liquid submersion voids the warranty.

16. TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Resolution
Cracking noise, static, interference	Make sure you are within range of your Bluetooth-enabled device
No sound or low volume	Check the volume on both your headset and device; both control the sound
Not charging	If using the wall charger, make sure it is plugged in to a powered outlet. If using the charging cable, make sure it is connected to a powered USB source such as a powered on computer, powered USB hub, or powered car USB port.
Won't pair	Make sure the AF12 is in pairing mode as indicated by the alternating flashing red and blue lights.
Won't connect	Make sure your AF12 is powered on and Bluetooth is enabled on your device. Make sure your device is not connected to any other Bluetooth headset. If connecting still fails, power off your AF12 and turn it back on. If problems persist, delete the AF12 from the list of paired Bluetooth devices and pair the AF12 again.
Won't control calls/media players	The AF12 headset is compatible with Bluetooth Version 1.1, 1.2, 2.0, and 2.1 and supports advanced A2DP operation. Some functions, such as "Rejecting a call", "Redialing" or "Voice dialing" are only available if supported by your mobile phone. Please check the phone manual for further information.
Won't turn on or turns on and then off	Charge your AF12
The audio stops and the unit turns off	Charge your AF12
Volume won't go louder and you hear a beep	You are at the maximum volume. The volume control on many devices will also control the overall volume of the AF12; adjust your device volume accordingly.
